AMAZON

SINCE 2006 THE AMAZON REGIONAL PROTECTED AREA (ARPA) PROGRAM HAS ADDED APPROXIMATELY 14.8 MILLION ACRES OF NEW PROTECTED AREAS. THE FULL ARPA SYSTEM NOW INCLUDES A TOTAL OF 57 FEDERAL AND STATE PROTECTED AREAS TOTALING 77.8 MILLION ACRES, WITH PROPOSALS TO ESTABLISH 27.2 MILLION ACRES MORE OVER TIME.

WWF'S AMAZON HEADWATERS INITIATIVE HAS IMPROVED THE MANAGEMENT OF 25.7 MILLION ACRES IN THE SOUTHWEST AMAZON WITHIN STRICT-PROTECTION AND MULTIPLE-USE PROTECTED AREAS AS WELL AS WITHIN INDIGENOUS TERRITORIES.

WWF AND ITS PARTNERS INFLUENCED FSC CERTIFICATION OF 1.1 MILLION ACRES OF FOREST CONCESSIONS IN PERU (968,600 ACRES IN FIVE FOREST CONCESSION ENTERPRISES, 86,500 ACRES IN INDIGENOUS COMMUNITIES, AND 81,500 ACRES IN BRAZIL NUT CONCESSIONS). AN ADDITIONAL 244,600 ACRES ARE UNDERGOING PRE-EVALUATION FOR CERTIFICATION IN 2007

BORNEO

WWF HELPED ORCHESTRATE AN INTERNATIONAL AGREEMENT THAT WILL SET THE FRAMEWORK FOR CONSERVATION IN THE HEART OF BORNEO WELL INTO THE FUTURE. THE NATIONAL GOVERNMENTS OF INDONESIA, MALAYSIA AND BRUNEI SIGNED THE HEART OF BORNEO DECLARATION TO MARK THEIR COLLECTIVE COMMITMENT TO PROTECTING AND SUSTAINABLY MANAGING 60 MILLION ACRES

THE SABAH FORESTRY DEPARTMENT DECLARED SUSTAINABLE FOREST MANAGEMENT AND PROTECTION OF KEY WILDLIFE HABITATS IN 568,000 ACRES INSIDE HEART OF BORNEO, WHILE THE GOVERNMENT OF RIAU IS FIGHTING CORRUPTION AND ILLEGAL LOGGING WITH EVIDENCE COLLECTED AND ANALYZED BY WWF'S "EYES ON THE FOREST" INITIATIVE.

CONGO BASIN

IN DECEMBER 2006, THE 1.85 MILLION ACRE TUMBA-LEDIIMA RESERVE WAS ESTABLISHED IN THE DRC. THIS IS A VITAL AREA FOR THE ENDANGERED BONOBO.

COASTAL EAST AFRICA

WE HELPED THE GOVERNMENT OF MOZAMBIQUE TO ACQUIRE AND LAUNCH THREE ENFORCEMENT BOATS AND TWO SUPPLY BOATS FOR THE FISHING ASSOCIATION IN

PRIMEIRAS AND SEGUNDAS.. THE BOATS ARE JOINTLY OPERATED BY LOCAL COMMUNITY GUARDS, THE FISHING ASSOCIATIONS, AND THE MOZAMBICAN NAVY. WE ALSO FACILITATED THE ACQUISITION OF TWO BOATS IN QUIRIMBAS NATIONAL PARK AND TWO BOATS IN BAZARUTO ARCHIPELAGO NATIONAL PARK. THIS HAS CHANGED THE SITUATION ON THE GROUND OVERNIGHT. ILLEGAL INDUSTRIAL FISHING BY THE DOMESTIC PRAWN FLEET AND BY FOREIGN FISHING FLEETS FROM CHINA, TAIWAN, ETC. HAS STOPPED. WITH ALMOST ALL ILLEGAL INDUSTRIAL SHRIMP TRAWLERS NOW EFFECTIVELY EXCLUDED FROM PRIMEIRAS AND SEGUNDAS, SOME OF THE LARGEST SEA GRASS BEDS IN COASTAL EAST AFRICA ARE BEGINNING TO RECOVER.

NORTHERN GREAT PLAINS

WE HELPED THE AMERICAN PRAIRIE FOUNDATION ACQUIRE 60,000 ACRES OF PRAIRIE; NEARLY TRIPLD THE BISON HERD; REINTRODUCED 722 PRAIRIE DOGS INTO 7 COLONIES IN A BLACK-FOOTED FERRET RECOVERY AREA; REMOVED FISH PASSAGE BARRIERS, OPENING 5 MILES OF TELEGRAPH CREEK AND 1.2 MILES OF BOXELDER CREEK; PLANTED 3,850 WOODY RIPARIAN PLANTS; REMOVED THREE DAMS; AND RESTORED A HALF-MILE OF DEGRADED CHANNEL.

NEPAL

PROJECT UNICORNIS CUT THE NUMBER OF RHINOS POACHED FROM 20 IN 2006 TO ONE IN 2007. THIS WAS ACCOMPLISHED THROUGH EXTENSIVE ANTIPOACHING AND ANTI-WILDLIFE TRAFFICKING EFFORTS, INCLUDING MOBILIZATION OF LARGE NUMBERS OF LOCAL COMMUNITY MEMBERS, UNDERCOVER INFORMANT NETWORKS, AND HEIGHTENED PARK PROTECTION.

NAMIBIA

THE NAMIBIAN COMMUNAL CONSERVANCY MOVEMENT HAS CREATED AN UNEXPECTED BUT IMPRESSIVE NATIONAL CONSERVATION MOVEMENT THAT IS HAVING LARGE LANDSCAPE CONSERVATION IMPACTS. IN THE PAST YEAR, 293,300 ACRES WERE ADDED TO CONSERVANCIES ACROSS THE COUNTRY. ALMOST 14 PERCENT OF THE NAMIBIAN POPULATION RESIDES IN COMMUNAL CONSERVANCIES.

NAMIBIA'S CONSERVATION-RELATED BENEFITS - MEASURED IN TERMS OF ECONOMIC ACTIVITY ATTRIBUTABLE TO NATURE-RELATED TOURISM AND OTHER CONSERVATION FACTORS - ROSE BY MORE THAN 30 PERCENT TO N\$26,834,772 OR THE EQUIVALENT OF US\$3,983,430.

A KEY PART OF THE SUCCESS OF THE CONSERVANCY PROGRAM HAS BEEN ITS ABILITY TO MAKE LOCAL-TO-GLOBAL MARKET LINKAGES IN THE TOURISM AND HUNTING INDUSTRIES. THESE INDUSTRIES ARE PROVIDING APPROXIMATELY 90 PERCENT OF THE CONSERVANCY BENEFITS AND ARE THE DRIVING FORCE BEHIND SECURING COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT.
